ACAP - After School Program

K-6 students participating in the ACAP

After School Program experience a varied curriculum that supports academic achievement, physical, and emotional well being. Students are offered a choice of activities each day, including arts and crafts, computer time, games, free play, and indoor/outdoor time. Students are also provided with homework assistance and activities that promote academic enrichment, character education, team building, and prevention.

The ACAP After School Program will start the first day of school – September 6, 2011 and runs through the first week of June 2012. Program hours are from school dismissal till 6:00 pm. The program is open every day that school is in session, except early dismissal days.

Applications are available through the Willsboro Central School's main office, or by calling ACAP directly at 873-3207 ext. 234. Students must be pre-registered prior to attending the program. Priority is given to students previously enrolled in the program, and registration of new students is on a first come, first serve basis. There is a \$75.00 per child/ per month fee. For families with more than one child, the second child fee is \$37.50, third is \$18.50. Assistance is available for those who qualify.
