Dear Community Members,

On April 29, 2019, the Willsboro Central School District Board of Education adopted the proposed budget of \$9,697,420 for the 2019-2020 school year, which will be voted on by the community on May 21, 2019. This budget results in a tax levy increase of 4.03%. Academic programs will all be maintained with the emphasis on ensuring all students receive an excellent education in a safe environment.

Developing a budget is always a complex task; the members of the Board of Education are presenting a proposed budget that they believe is educationally sound and also fiscally responsible. Our commitment to provide quality programs and services to everyone involved in our school community is our focus throughout the budget process.

Please join us at our Budget Hearing on May 14^{th} in the auditorium at 6:00 pm and come out and vote on May 21st. The detailed budget, along with the District's academic report card, will be available to the public on May 7^{th} in the District Office and can also be found on the school's website. Thank you for your continued support of all of the students that attend Willsboro Central School.
