

Dear Willsboro CSD School Community,

Today, January 25, 2021, the district has learned that an individual at Willsboro Central School has tested positive for COVID-19. **The individual is a student that last attended school on Monday, January 11<sup>th</sup>.**

**Due to the fact that the student has not attended classes in-person since January 11<sup>th</sup>, no other individuals at WCS are expected to be quarantined from this positive case.**

Please note that the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) and other privacy laws restrict us from disclosing or confirming any personally identifiable information. We cannot identify anyone who has tested positive or been quarantined.

**It is important to know that:**

- All students are required to be screened and have temperature checks completed daily.
- All students and staff are required to wear masks.
- Classroom desks are set up with appropriate social distancing and students have assigned seats.
- Seating assignments and social distancing also occurs on school buses.
- Classrooms, buses, and common areas are disinfected and sanitized daily, as well as between student use.

**At this time, in-person classes will continue for all grade levels at WCS.**
